Carol Sando has been a nurse for over 30 years, and a teacher for over 20 years. Currently she is an Assistant Professor of Nursing at Neumann College in Aston, Pennsylvania where she teaches undergraduate clinical courses in Adult Health and Research, Master's degree courses in the Nurse Educator track, and continuing education classes in faith-based nursing. Recent accomplishments are the newly implemented Division of Nursing graduate program at Neumann College: the Master's Degree in Instructional Leadership, the Faith-Based Nursing and Missionary certificate program sponsored by the Continuing and Professional Studies Division at Neumann, and NLN certification as a CNE. In addition to serving as the chair of the INACSL Membership Committee, she is also a member of the INACSL Web Site Committee.

Clinical and experiential learning, experimental methodology, and evaluation instrument development make up Carol's program of research. Additional professional interests include missionary nursing, mentorship, and clinical practice in gerontologic nursing.
