EXCELLENCE AWARD DESCRIPTION: “The Best Practice Innovator” award honors a member of INACSL who goes above and beyond the ordinary, to demonstrate extraordinary commitment and the use of innovative approaches in expanding, promoting, disseminating, and/or utilizing the INACSL Standards of Best Practice: SimulationSM.

This individual demonstrates outstanding accomplishments in some or all of the following areas:

Demonstrates leadership and advocacy for the INACSL Standards of Best Practice: SimulationSM by:

- Collaborating and networking with simulation groups (intra and/or interprofessional) at the local, regional, national or international level.
- Fostering an understanding of the need for best practice standards with stakeholder groups through contributions at civic, legislative, or professional association levels.

Advances the continued evolution and/or interpretation of the INACSL Standards of Best Practice: SimulationSM by:

- Interpreting professional standards of best practice for peers and/or public, reviews and/or analyzing standards of practice in a variety of settings.
- Advises on standards of best practice.
- Collaborating to develop or update standards for simulation.
- Engaging researchers, clinicians, and educators in the utilization of standards of best practice in simulation.

Expands understanding of best practice standards in simulation to increase the quality and quantity of best practices in simulation in nursing by:

- Assisting other nurses or health care professionals to acquire knowledge of simulation evidence-based standards.
- Mentoring others to interpret and apply best practice standards.



- Creating materials that promote knowledge translation of best practice standards.
- Promoting evaluation of simulation programs and various aspects of simulation against the standards of best practice in simulation.
- Presenting workshops/seminars on professional standards to stakeholder groups and other healthcare disciplines.

Engages in intentional and explicit utilization of best practice standards in simulation to advance nursing practice (e.g. Quality Care Improvement; Person/Family Centered Care; Patient Safety; Interprofessional Education) through:

- Employing best practice standards in simulation to improve patient care.
- Implementation of best practice standards in simulation in a defined area of nursing practice.

2. One **letter of support** that clearly demonstrates support for the nominee and a statement evidencing that the nominee has meet the criteria as detailed on the awards rubric (word doc, word docx, pdf).



3. The nominee's "**Abbreviated CV**" specific to Best Practice Innovator Award (max 3 pages – CVs in excess of 3 pages will only consider the first 3 pages of the CV)
